### Become a Coach

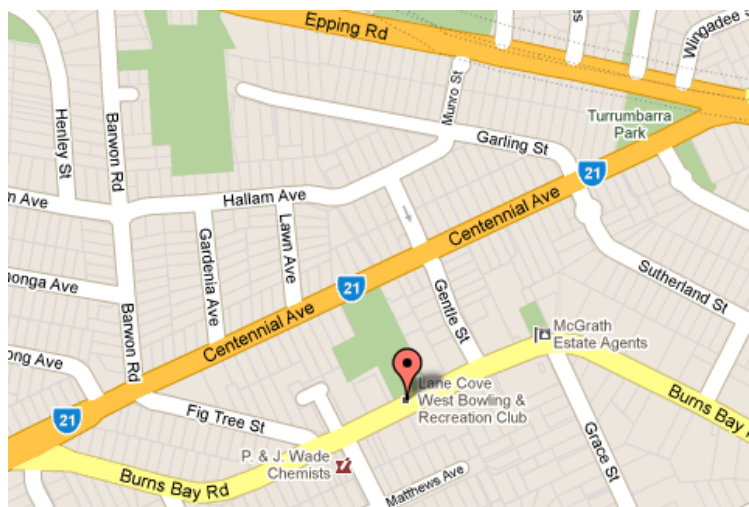

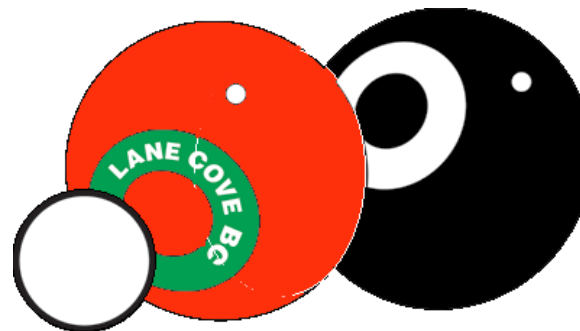
