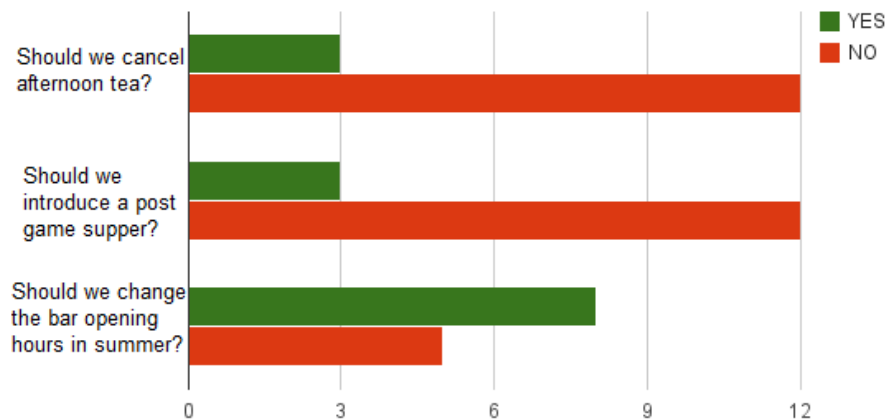


Become a Coach

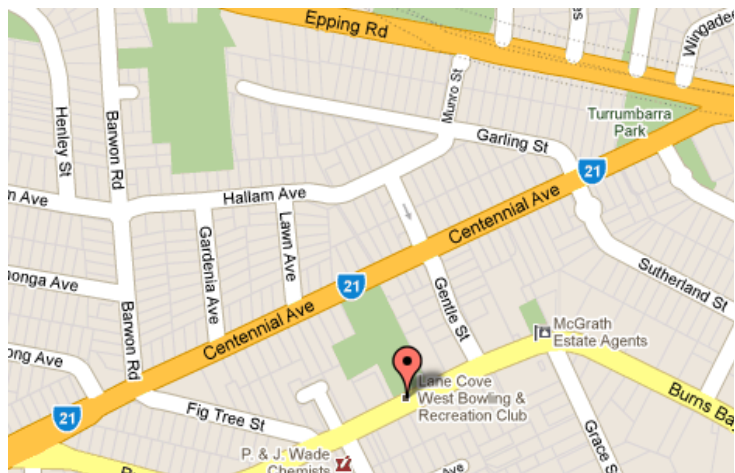

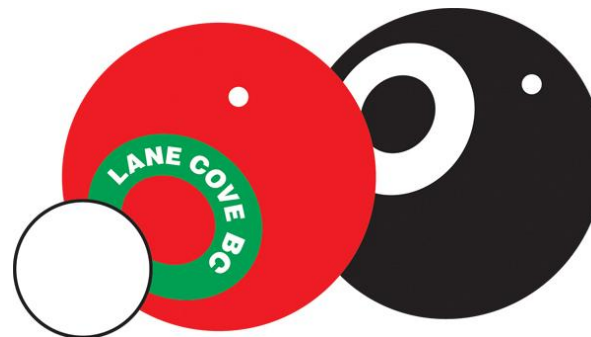
